Włodzimierz Szturc was born in 1959 in Wisła, southern Poland. He teaches comparative study of literature at the Jagiellonian University and history of drama at the School of Drama in Cracow. He was a guest lecturer at the Institute National des Langues et Civilisations Orientales in Paris. At present he teaches a course in world literature at the François Rabelais University in Tours. He cooperates with a number of institutions, including the Centre de Recherche sur L'Imaginaire (Grenoble) and the Frans Roggen Foundation (Ghent).

Włodzimierz Szturc is the author of several critical studies; he is also a translator and journalist. He has published four books: *Ironia romantyczna (Romantic Irony)* 1992, *Osiem szkiców o ironii (Eight Essays on Irony)* 1994, „Faust” Geothego. *Ku antropologii romantycznej (Goethe's Faust. Towards an Anthropology of Romanticism)* 1995, *O obrotach sfer romantycznych. Studia o ideach i wyobraźni (On the Revolution of the Romantic Orbs. Studies on Ideas and Imagination)* 1997.
